

PEAK Online Courses Information and Application

PEAK online is PUSD's supplemental course delivery program available through Internet access for high school students. Students who want to take courses online will be able to through the PEAK program, offering 2 courses with a maximum of one fresh course, per six-week session. Students must complete a PEAK Online application to be considered for course approval through their academic advisor. Once the application is completed by the student and pre-approved by the academic advisor, the following steps must be followed:

- Pay the one time \$5.00 Fee to the bookstore. **Please present receipt to PEAK staff.**
- PHS/PEAK student must either have a PHS/NELA student-parking permit to park on the NELA campus.
- Hand deliver the application to the PEAK lab during PEAK hours to sign up for orientation.
- Return the application to your academic advisor for final approval.

Applications will be available for the following session during each session in progress. Only one application may be turned in at a time.
